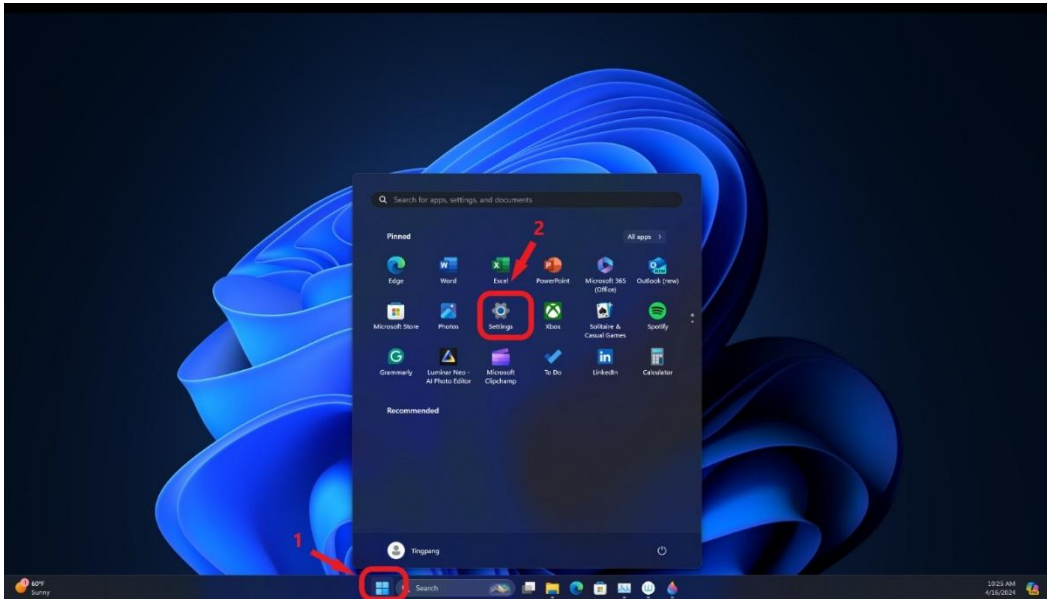
If you already have Remote Desktop enabled in the target host, you should still record the IP address of the target host as it is required to access the target when you use PMG to do Remote Desktop.

Section 1. iOS Device Client accessing Windows 11 Pro Host

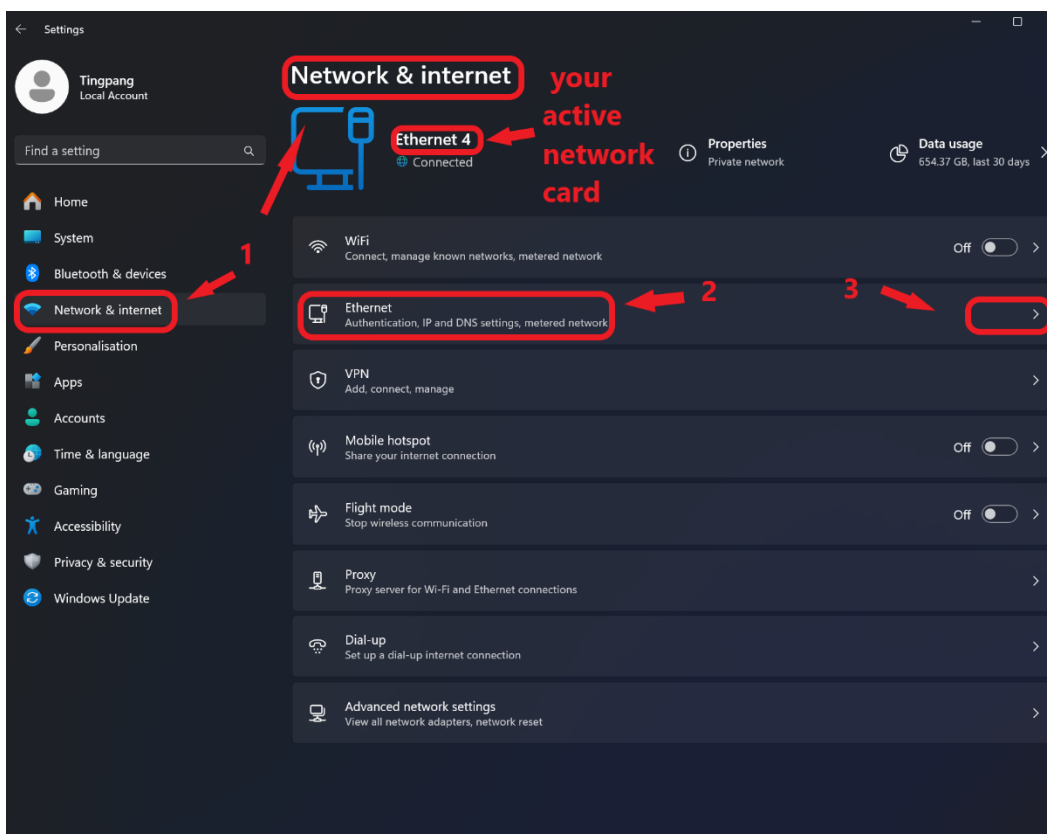
1.1 Enable Windows 11 Pro Host for Remote Desktop Access

Requirement: Windows 11 Pro is required for Remote Desktop service, please upgrade your windows 11 to "Pro" version if it is not.

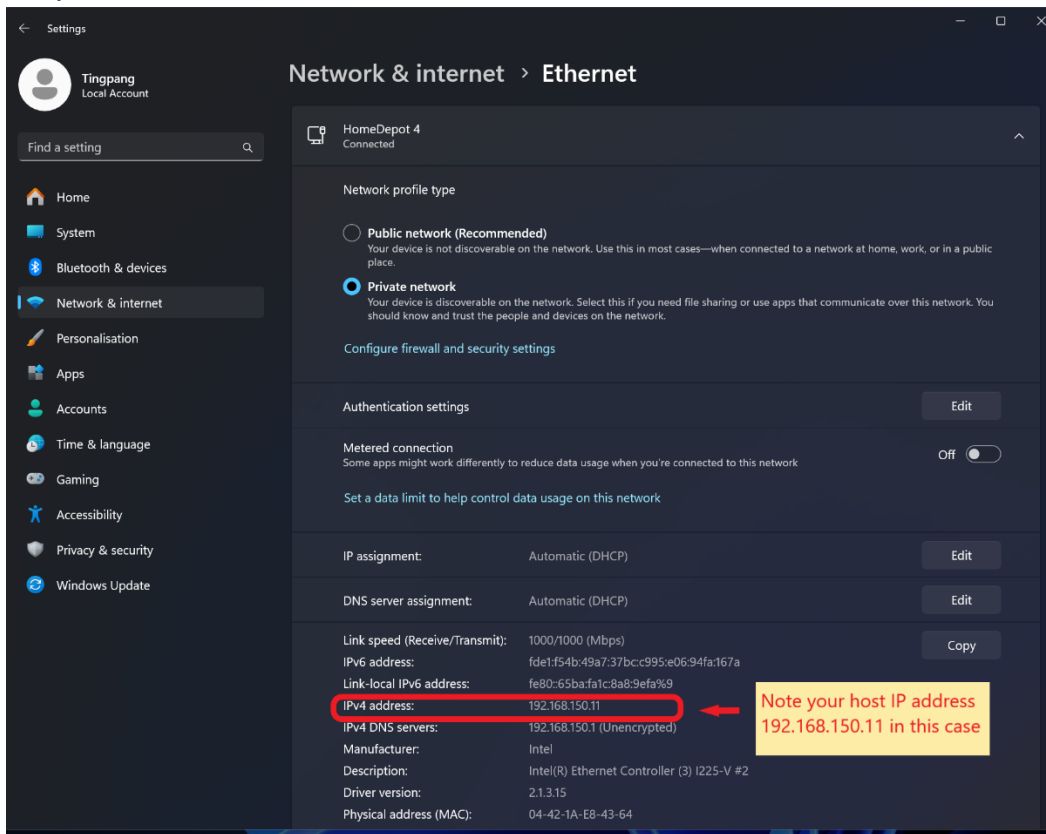
Step 1. (1)Click on Windows icon --> (2) Select Settings



Step 2. (1) Select Network & Internet → (2) Ethernet (Pick the one that is enabled/active) → (3)Right Arrow to expand next window

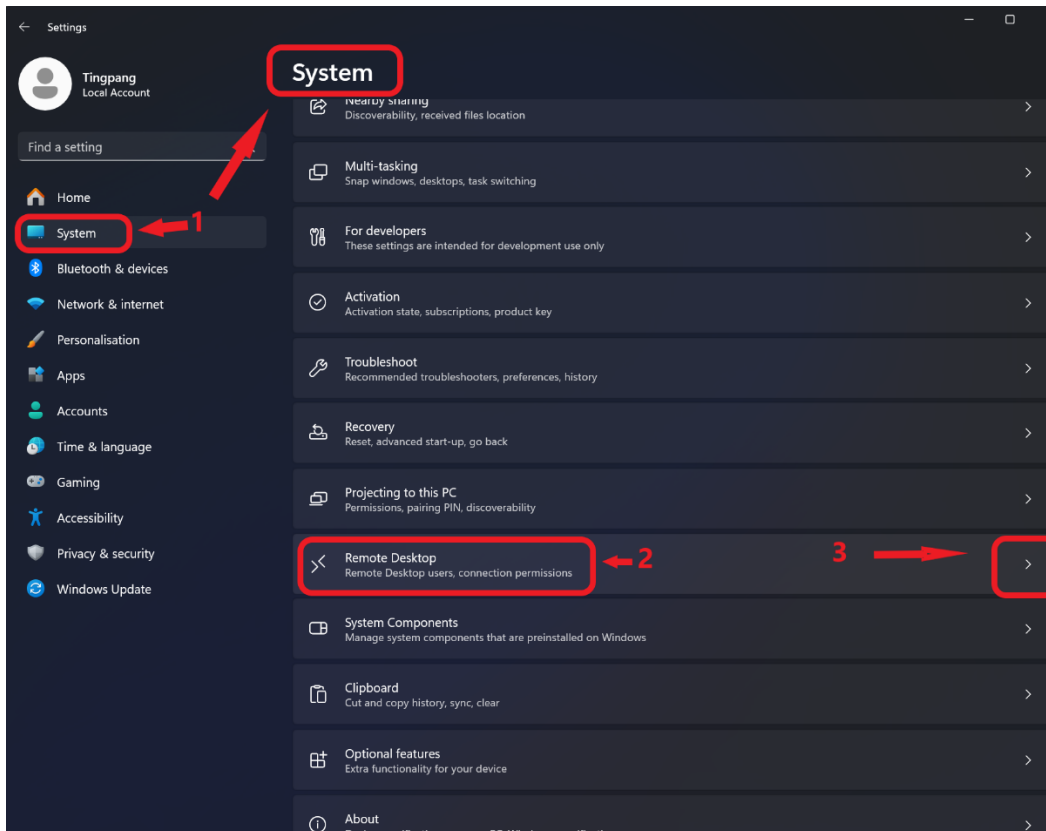


Step 3. Locate and Record Your Host's IP Address

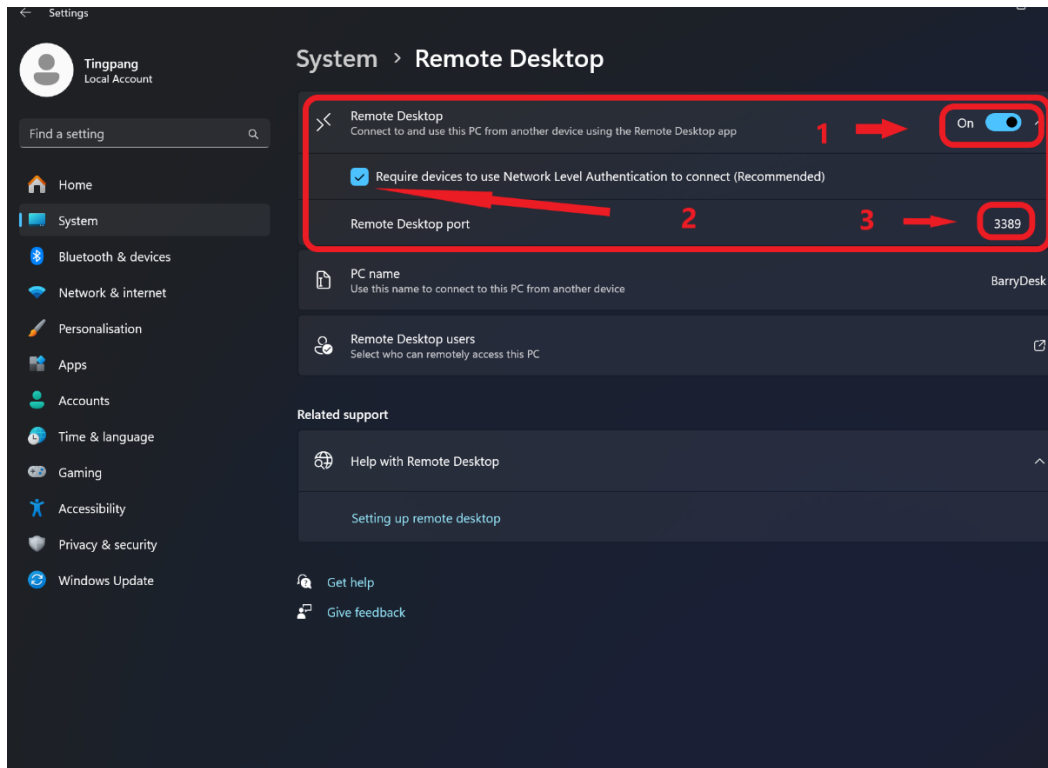

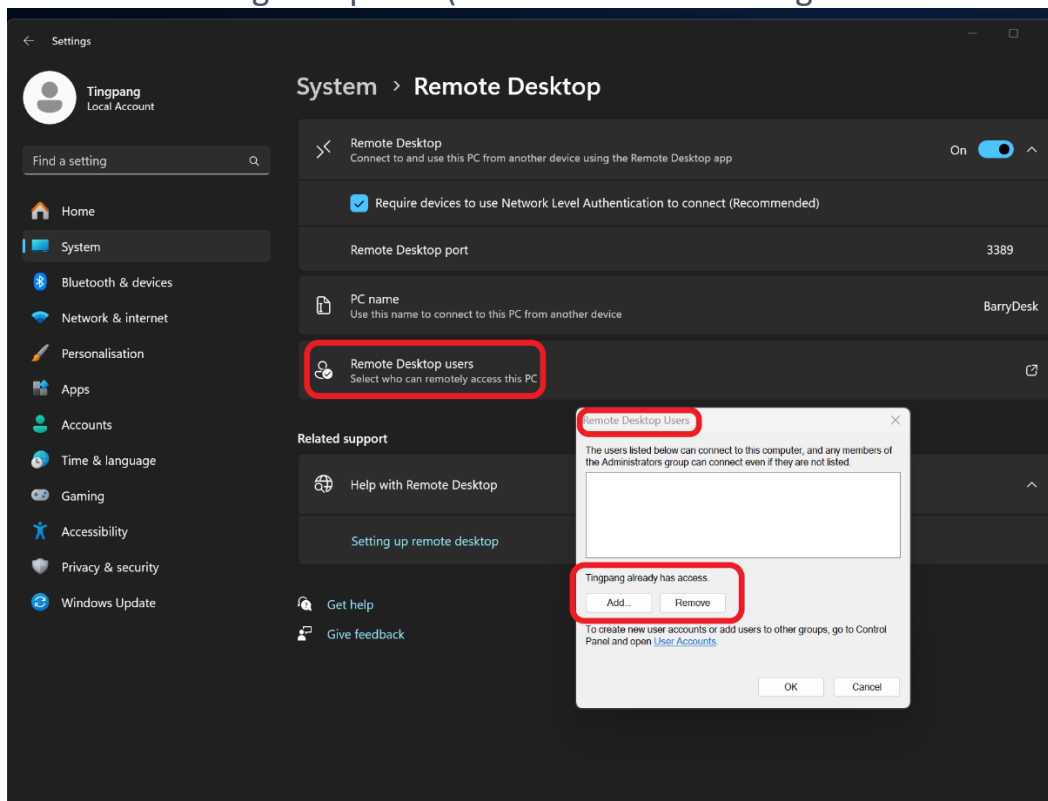
Step 4. (1) System → (2) Remote Desktop → (3) click on the arrow to expand next window



Step 5. (1) Switch on Remote Desktop → (2) Require Network Level Authentication to connect (recommended) → (3) Note the port number if you have changed it.



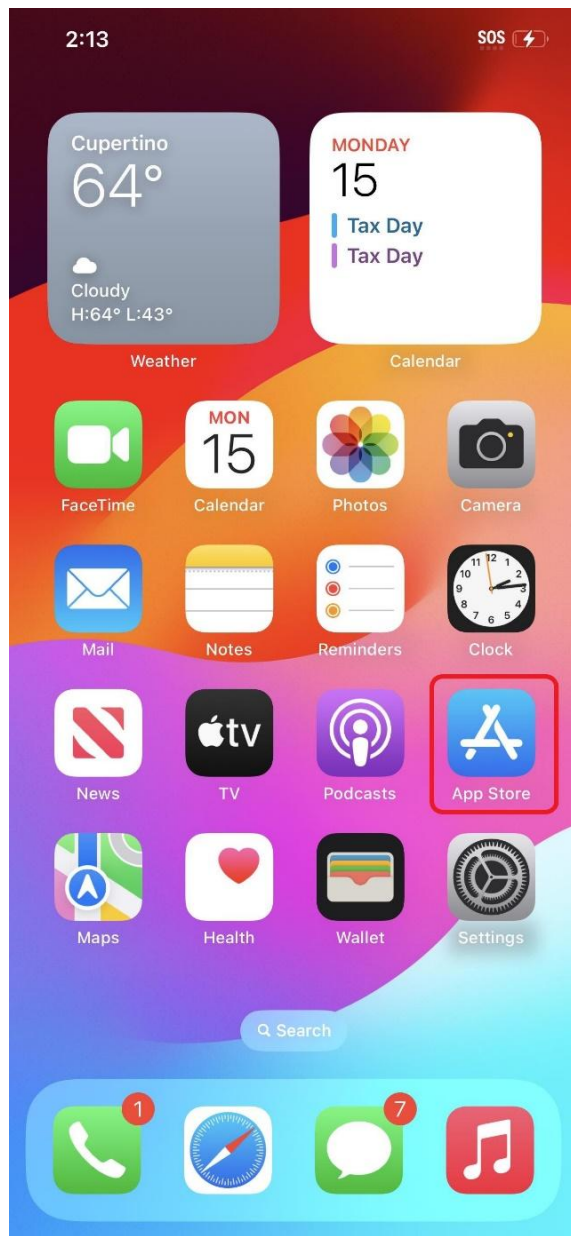
Step 6. Modify user setting to allow access → Remote Desktop Users, click on arrow → Add users setting if required (the current user can sign on Remote Desktop by default)



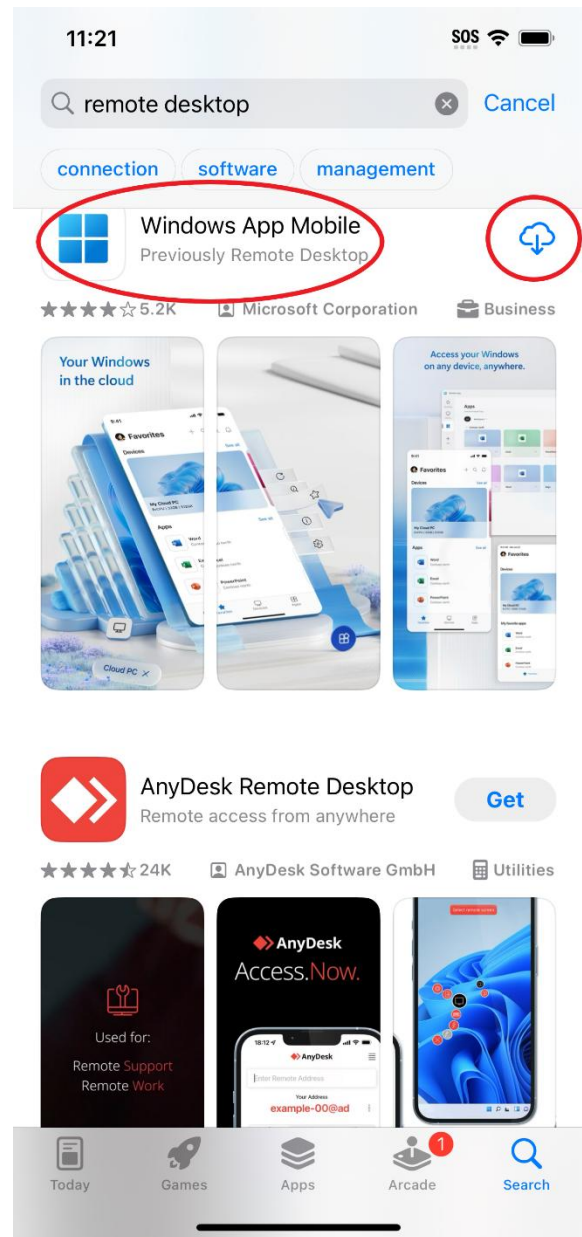
Your Windows 11 Pro Host is now setup to accept Remote Desktop request now.

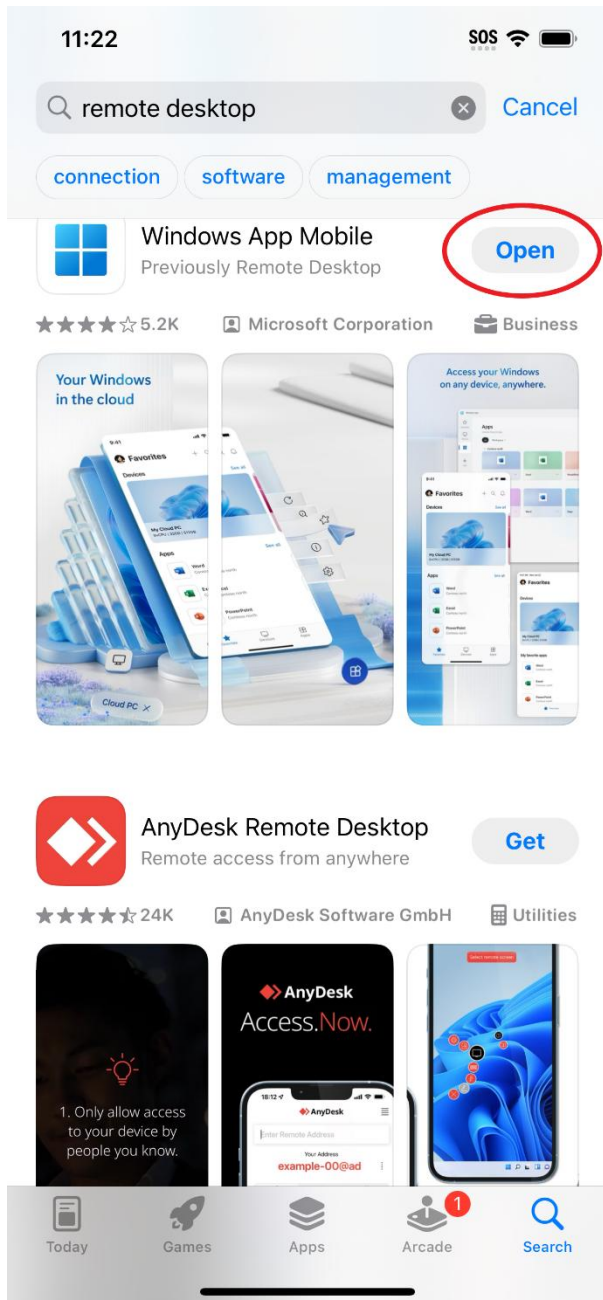

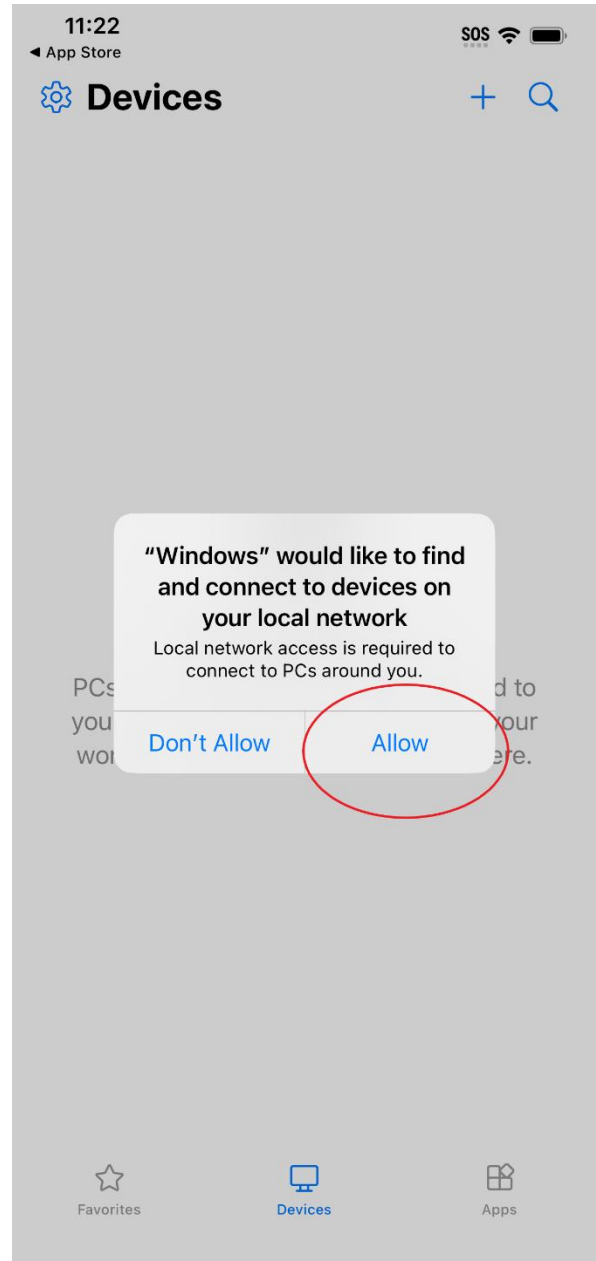

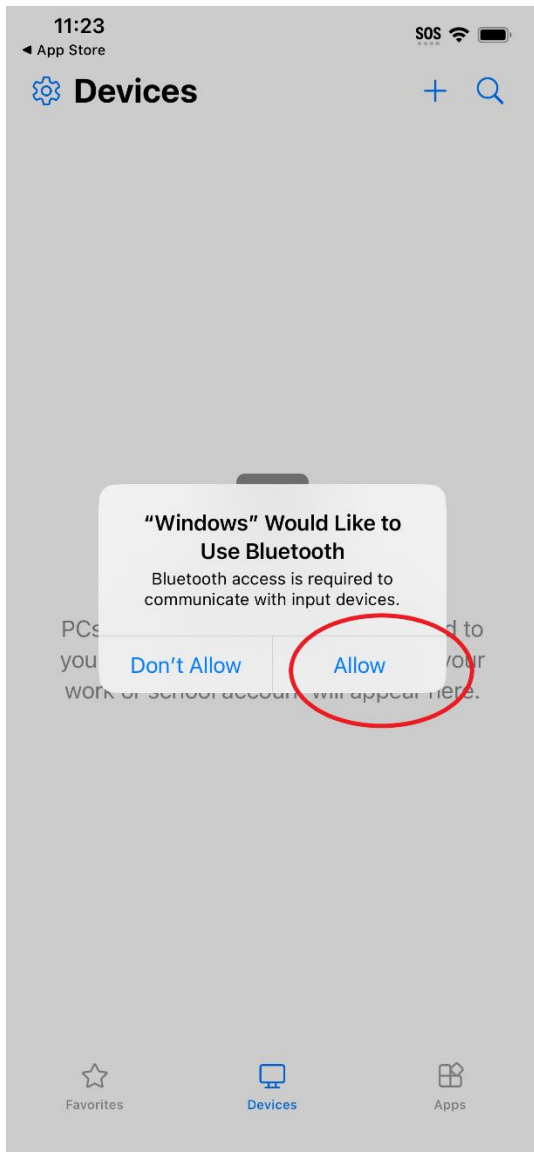
Step 3 Open Windows App Mobile



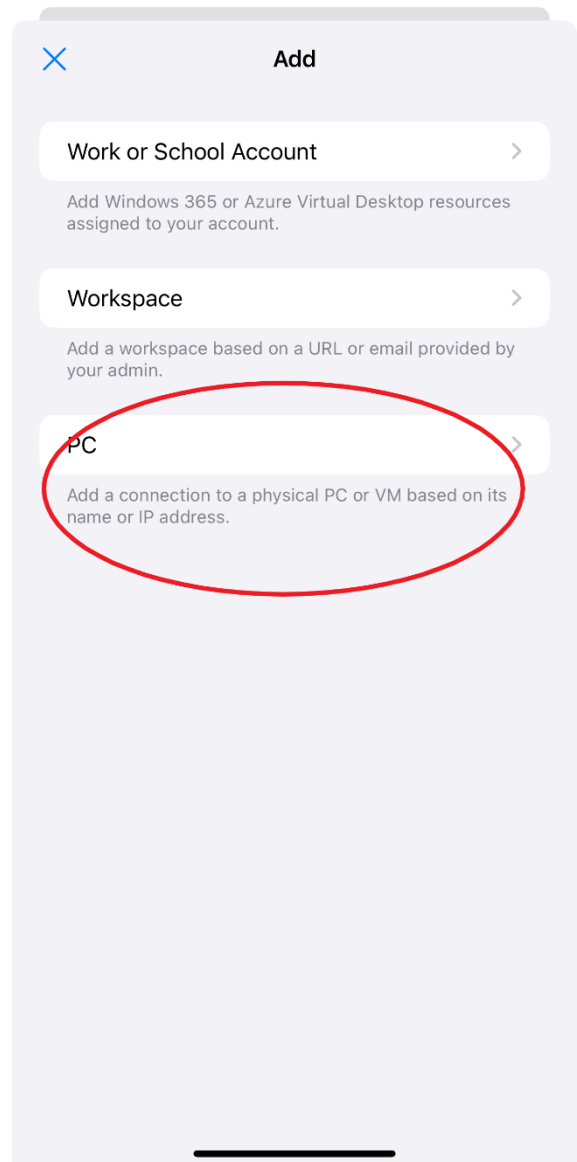
Step 4 Allow Windows App Mobile to search LAN

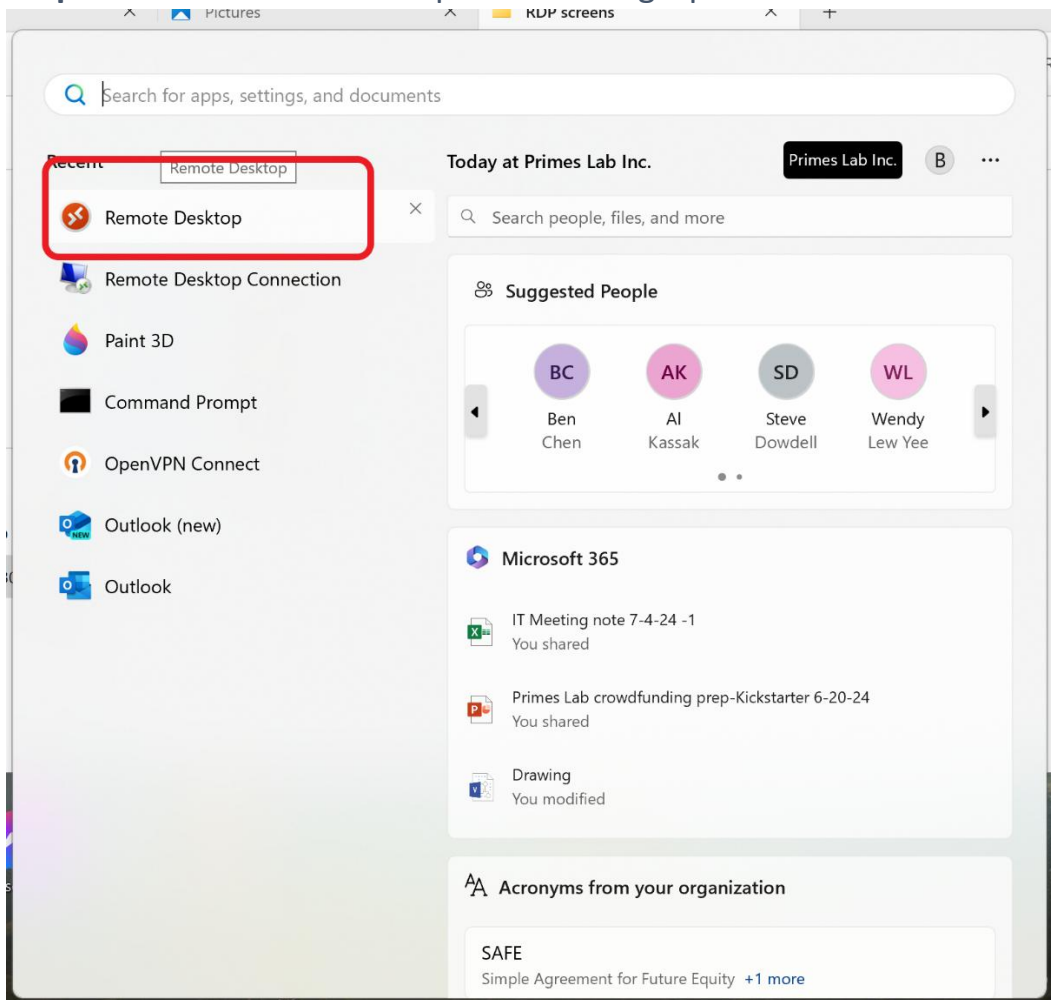
Step 1 Start → search Microsoft Store, then click on Microsoft Store



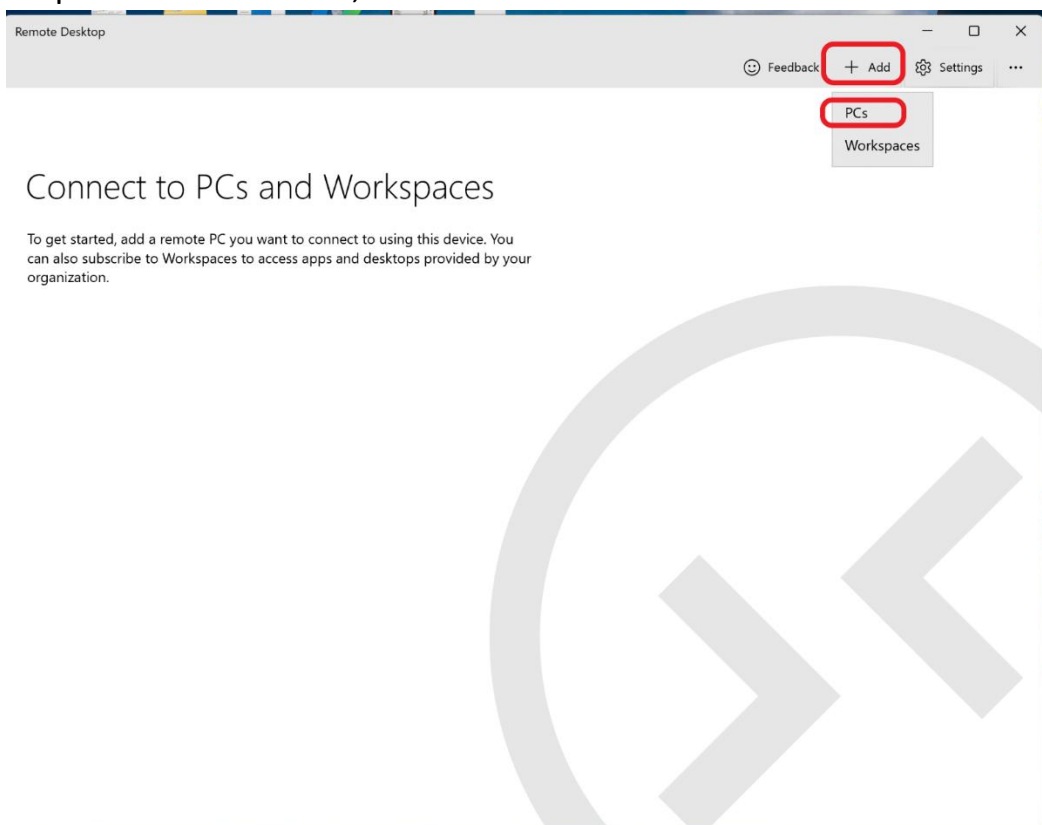
Step 2 Search remote desktop and Get to install



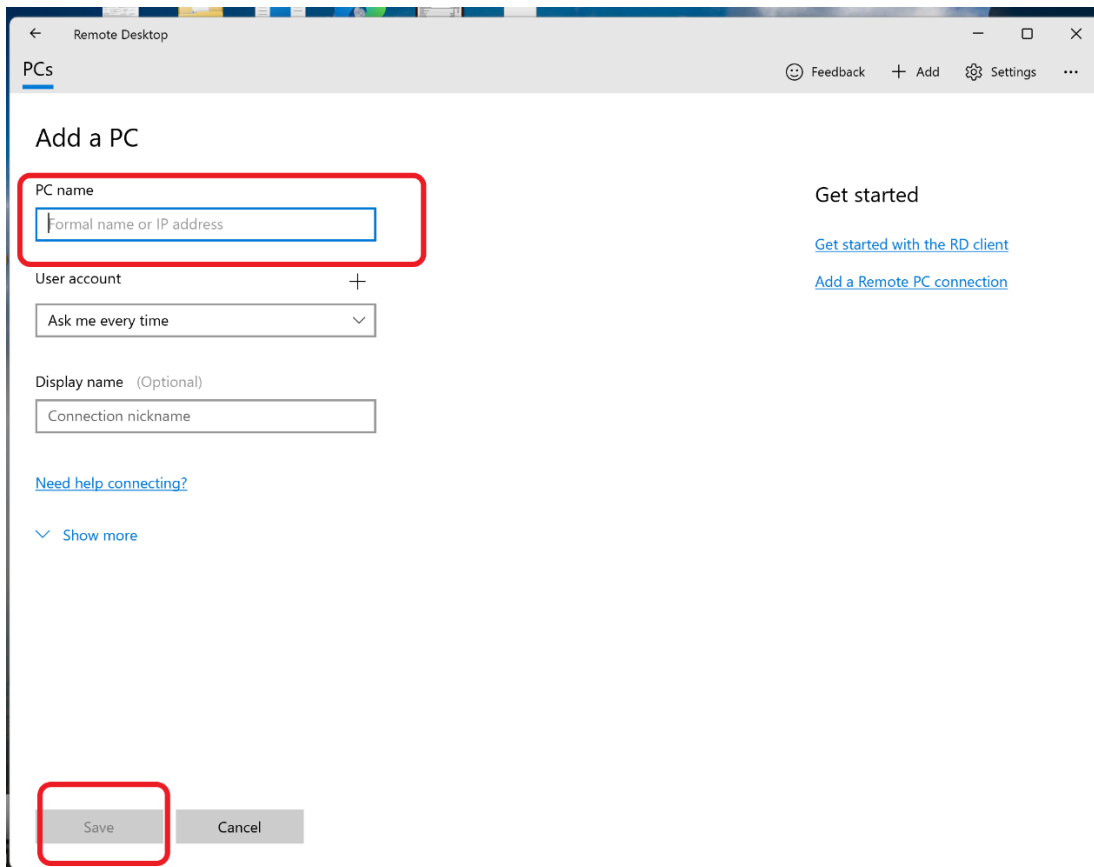
Step 3 Start Remote Desktop after making OpenVPN connection to PMG



Step 4 Click on the "+", and select "PC"

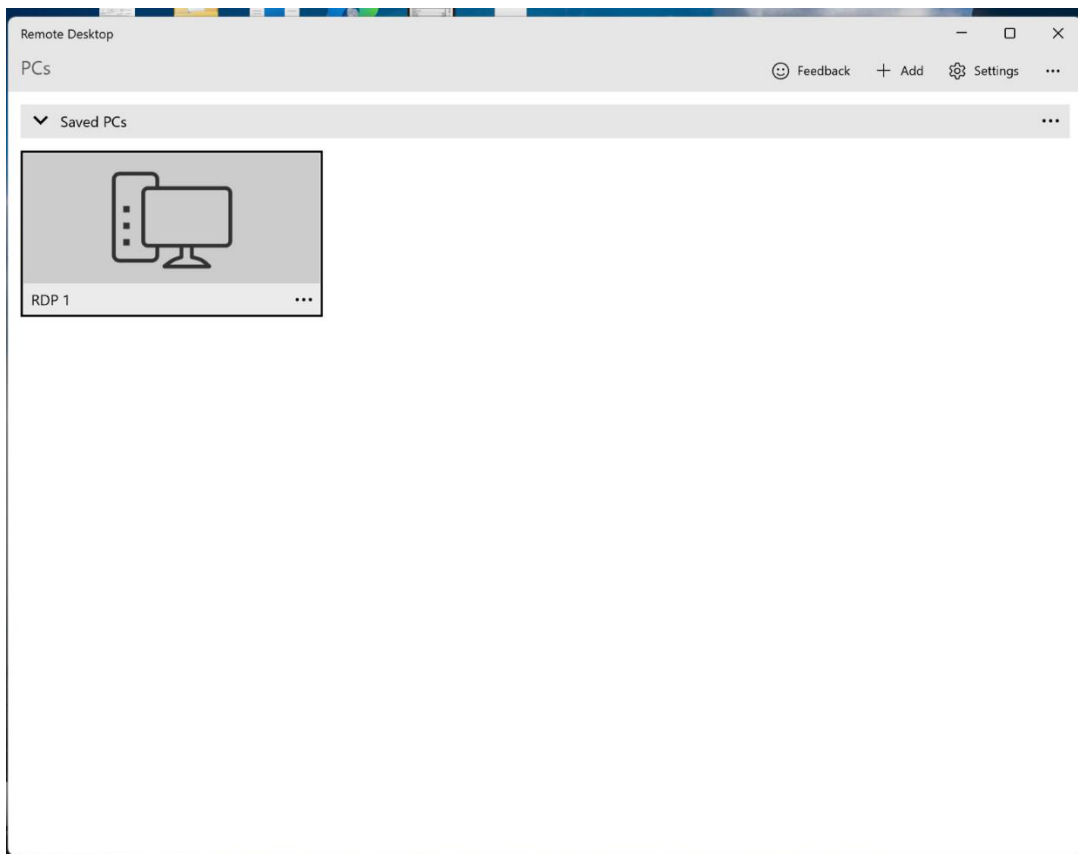


Step 5 Enter the IP and click on Save

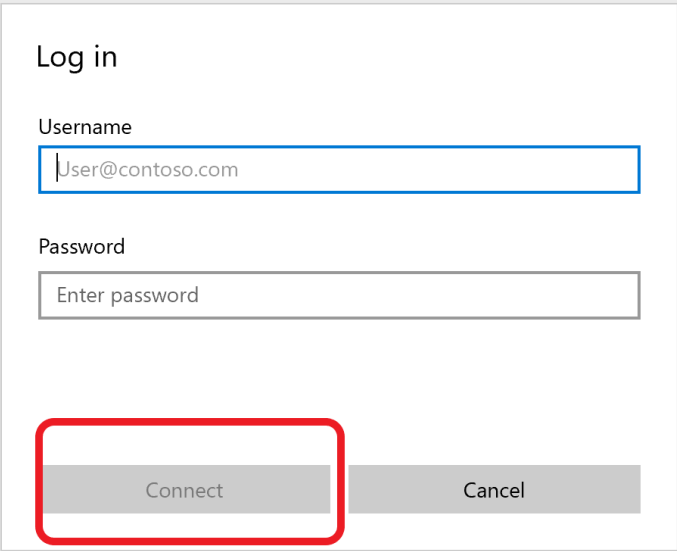

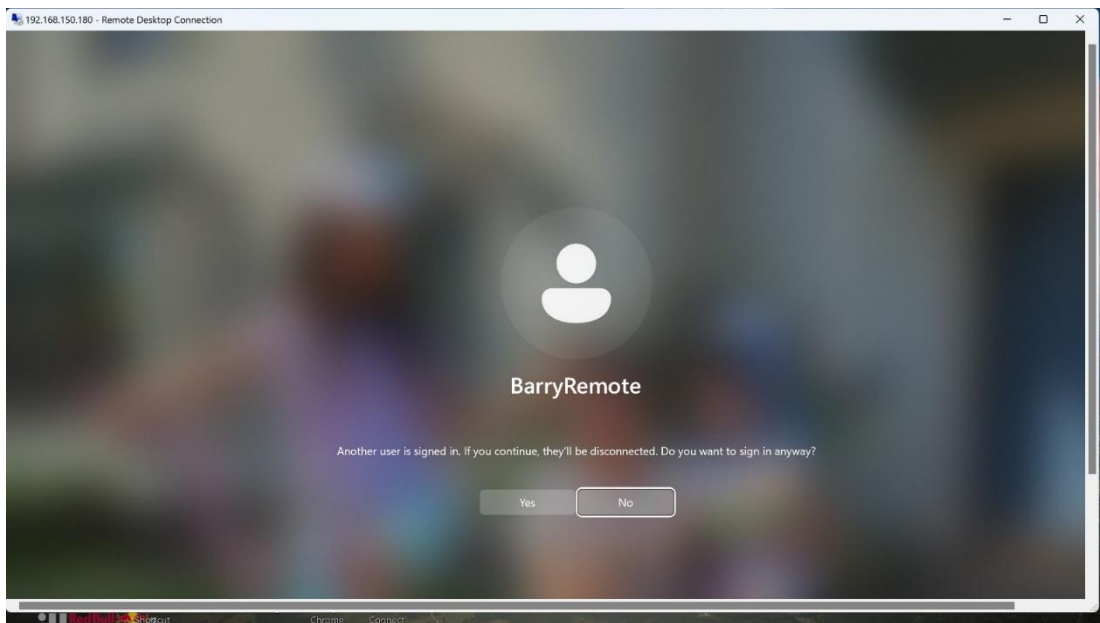

4.2 Setup macOS Remote Desktop Client

- 1 **Download the Microsoft Remote Desktop for Mac client:** Open the Mac App Store and search for "Microsoft Remote Desktop for Mac." Download and install the app.
- 2 **Make OpenVPN connection:** Use OpenVPN Connect app to connect to PMG.
- 3 **Launch RDP client app:** Launch the Microsoft Remote Desktop for Mac client from your Applications folder or Launchpad.
 - 3.1 **Add a PC:** Click on the "+" button and select "Add PC" to add the Windows host you want to connect to.
 - 3.2 **Enter details:** Enter the IP address of the Windows PC, and the credentials (username and password) for the Windows account. (Note: Windows Host IP address is required. Consult the Remote Desktop Host section of this document for locating the Host IP address if you don't have it already.)
 - 3.3 **Connect:** Click "Save" and then "Connect" to start the remote session.
- 4 After you finish your RDP session, please remember to disconnect the OpenVPN connection to your PMG to resume normal operation.

Section 5. Setup iOS Device Client accessing Windows 10 Pro Host

5.1 Enable Windows 10 Pro Host for Remote Desktop Access

Requirement: Windows 10 Pro is required for Remote Desktop service, please upgrade your windows 10 to "Pro" version if it is not.

Steps:

1. Open Settings.
2. Click on System.
3. Select Remote Desktop.
4. Toggle the Enable Remote Desktop switch to On.
5. Confirm when prompted.

Your Windows 10 Pro Host is now setup to accept Remote Desktop request now.

To Locate the IP address of your Target Host

Steps: (To be performed at your target host)

1. **Open Settings:** Click on the Start menu and select the gear icon to open Settings.
2. **Go to Network & Internet:** In the Settings window, click on "Network & Internet".
3. **Select Wi-Fi or Ethernet:** Choose either "Wi-Fi" or "Ethernet" depending on your connection type.
4. **View Properties:** Click on the network you're connected to, then click "Properties".
5. **Find IP Address:** Under "Properties," look for your IP address listed next to "IPv4 address".
6. **Record the IP address.**
